Abstract Submission Guidelines

Authors wishing to submit an abstract for a flash oral presentation or poster only are requested to submit a maximum of 50 words for the abstract title and 350 words for the abstract text in English.

Category

The organisers have decided not to have specific categories to receive abstract submissions in. When reviewing the abstracts, they will select and allocate them within the programme where appropriate.

All abstracts need to be submitted via the online abstract submission form.

When submitting your abstract, please note the following important instructions:

- Without exception, late submissions will not be accepted after Midnight (GMT), Monday 31 January, 2022
- Successful flash oral poster presenters will be notified soon after the abstract submission deadline
- All authors (poster only, and flash oral presentations and poster) will be required to register separately and pay the appropriate registration fee
- At the time of submitting your abstract you will be asked to select the type of presentation you would like to give
- For abstracts where **Flash oral presentation** is selected, a small number will be chosen for short (2 minute) talks. All other submitted abstracts will be accepted as **posters**. Abstracts selected for a flash oral presentation **must also** be presented as a poster.

Poster Presentations

Posters will be on display throughout the conference. There will also be allocated Poster Sessions.

If you intend to submit an abstract for Poster Presentation please note the following:

- Poster boards are 1.8 metres high and 0.9 metres wide. It is recommended that displays do not exceed 1.5 metres in length.
