### **Abstract Submission Guidelines**

We are inviting abstracts from all corners of the prevention research community - so whether you are conducting research into the primary prevention of non-communicable diseases or developing interventions to reduce health inequalities and illness - all are welcome to submit.

Please read the following guidelines before submitting your abstract.

All abstracts need to be submitted via the online abstract submission form.

# Poster or Oral presentation submission guidelines:

- Abstract submission deadline Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- Maximum 250 words or less
- Single person presentation
- The suggested format for the abstract text is Intro/Methods/Results/Conclusions
- Oral presentations will be 10-minutes with 5 minutes for questions
- All presenters will be required to register to attend Prevention Research 2026 separately, and pay the appropriate registration fee
- Authors will be advised of the decision by Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025

### **Symposium submission guidelines:**

- Abstract submission deadline Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- Maximum 1,250 words or less
- Up to 4 people presenting
- The submitted abstract is proposed to be made up of up to four individual abstracts, compiled together into a coherent session
- The abstract should also include a background/topic description (approx. 250 words)
- Space out each individual abstract or topic area within the given text box for the abstracts and state the presenting author of each abstract/topic area within the box
- Authors must nominate 1 author to submit the abstract and be the lead/corresponding author
- Symposia sessions will be 1hr, with a suggested structure of 50-minutes presenting, with 10 minutes for questions.
- All presenters will be required to register to attend Prevention Research 2026 separately, and pay the appropriate registration fee

Authors will be advised of the decision by Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025

## Workshop submission guidelines:

- Abstract submission deadline Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2025
- Maximum 400 words or less
- The workshop is an interactive session that is engaging for the audience on a particular theme or themes
- The workshop will either be 1 hour or 2 hours depending on your preference indicated when submitting the abstract, and subject to timetable allowing
- It is expected that workshops are facilitated by at least 2 facilitators/presenters
- All presenters will be required to register to attend Prevention Research 2026 separately, and pay the appropriate registration fee
- Authors will be advised of the decision by Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025
