Abstract Submission Guidelines

Authors wishing to submit an abstract for oral or poster presentation are requested to submit a maximum of 50 words for the abstract title and 200 words for the abstract text in English. This is to include the title and text.

Please follow the comprehensive instructions below as to how to submit. Please note the following important instructions:

Without exception, late submission will not be accepted after Midnight BST, Monday 17 May, 2021

Authors will be advised of the decision for oral presentations by end of May, 2021

All presenters (poster and oral) will be required to register separately and pay the appropriate registration fee.

At the time of submitting your abstract you will be asked to select the type of presentation you would like to give.

For abstracts where **oral presentation** is selected; a small number will be chosen for short (15 minute talks); all others will be accepted as **posters**. Abstracts selected for an oral presentation can **also** be presented as a poster.

Oral Presentations – Further information

- Oral Presentations will all be pre-recorded and will be 15 mins long.
- Presenting authors will be sent guidelines as to how to record their presentations and will be required to upload these to the virtual platform. Full instructions will be circulated prior to the meeting
- There will be a slightly different format during the live session where all the oral
 presentations will be played at the time of the session and oral presenters must be
 available during the live session to answer questions at the end of the session, rather
 than after each talk.

Poster Presentations – Further information

- Posters will be presented as an ePoster.
- Authors will be able to provide a 3-minute recording to accompany their ePoster
- There will be allocated ePoster sessions during the virtual meeting. Authors will be required to be available during these sessions to respond to live Q & A questions via Chat
- Presenting authors will be sent guidelines as to how to record their presentations and will be required to upload these to the virtual platform. Full instructions will be circulated
